Who we are?

YDC Dekameron was established in March 2012. and formally registered in May 2012. YDCD is established in order to implement Strategy for development of Youth Policy of the municipality of Ključ for 2012-2017. Objectives of YDCD are to work actively in order to: improve life standards of young people; strengthen mechanisms for youth participation in decision-making; strengthen mechanisms for the development of the general socio-economic, educational and cultural interests of youngsters; activate participation in public life and civil society building and promotion and development of the voluntarism and youth mobility. YDCD is part of the Youth Council and since now we realized several initiatives in a frame of Youth Strategy, mostly working on unemployment and voluntarism. Project that we are working on seven months is online youth counselor which is recognized as first project in our region that is based on social problems of young people and it is organized online.

Summary of the project

The aim of this seminar is to initiate the creation of a sustainable partnership between youth organizations, exchange good practices and create new methodologies, which can assist youth organizations to develop activities facing the issue of the youth employability and the inclusion of youth with fewer opportunities through innovative projects. The results of this seminar are expected to be a strong partnership and a new mapping of the challenges and needs for youth organizations, the reflection upon best practices, transfer of innovation and capacity building for youth workers. The PBA will run according to non-formal learning techniques and it will enable the creation of a long term partnership platform.

Methodology

We intend to use the methods of non-formal education in this project to share and debate through brainstormings, group discussions, small workshops, case studies, etc. The participants in this activity will have the opportunity to experience the methods of non-formal education, to share their experiences and learn from each other, as well as to be part of the collective design of new projects, strategies, approaches and tools in order to deal with youth unemployment.

The projects' activities will include:

Team building, ice-breaking activities expectations evaluation and needs assessment;

Theoretical inputs around key-competencies for youth work and non-formal education;

youth empowerment, inclusion, communication;

Presentation of the Youthpass;

Development of common project ideas, follow up activities and solid partnership proposals;

Experiential workshops;

Project design and management;

The Youth in Action Program and its role as a support to reinforce the position of people with

fewer opportunities in the labour market.

Accomodation

The participants, leaders and the team will be accommodated in the local Guest House "Zvizda", offering full board (taken there and in a restaurant nearby), double, triple and shared rooms, space

for intense work inside, as well as outside facilities.

Venue!!

The project activities will take place in Ključ, one of the most important places considering Bosnian history, a town and municipality by the same name in western Bosnia and Herzegovina. It is located in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, specifically the Una-Sana Canton. It is located a short distance south from Sanski Most. The Sana River runs through the municipality. The terrain is heavily

forested.
